Some of you hate it, and some of you love it. Others ignore it. So whether this raises your ire, your boredom, or your fascination, here is a short article for you:

Michael's Masonic Esoterica

Freemasonry is integrity and fidelity of trust. Integrity means we are honest to our core. Honest in our dealings with people, but most importantly honest with ourselves. Fidelity of trust means we will keep a secret. We swear to keep certain Masonic things secret, but I have a large library of books that dissect our secret words, tokens, symbols, our obligations and our footwork. These things we keep secret are not really so secret.

But there is a secret, and what is secret, what cannot be spoken of and cannot be written about, is the core mystery of Freemasonry. This core secret requires integrity, for if we are not honest about who we are, we miss out on the lesson of Freemasonry. This core secret requires fidelity of trust, for this brings us to a realization of who we really are.

This core secret is embodied in the Worshipful Master presiding under the very symbol of this core secret. The secret is not math and angles, though math and angles lead to it. The quotation from Genesis in the first degree was your first level of awakening to this secret and the tolling bell in the 3rd degree completed this awakening in you. You are not aware that this awakening has happened, for the secret of Masonry is not for you the thinker, the seer, the seeker to know. Indeed this awakening can not be known by the thinking individual, though awareness of the awakening will forever change your perceptions of the observable space and your relationship with it.

Everything that Freemasonry does is to awaken that eternal presence that is this moment. Note, not 'in' this moment, rather 'is' this moment. This moment is a constant expression of the Great Architect's immediate presence.

You can't know this thing that awakens because you are the thing you want to know. You seek something, but the thing you seek is the seeking itself. This sounds convoluted but actually is extremely simple. All that is, is a perfect union of incommensurate conjugate pair attributes. These attributes arise as the observable space, which includes the observing self. These incommensurate conjugate pair attributes of the Great Architect's immediate presence arise in harmony and perfection. At the core, this very moment right now is the perfect inertia of the One thing becoming. The One thing expresses as the arising of conjugate pairs. They are incommensurate because one can not exist without the other, and at

Relax all identification, and rest right here, right now.
